## Free vaccinations against Covid-19 will begin soon

- 新型コロナウイルスのワクチン無料接種が始まります

### For those aged 65 and above (including those who will turn 65 by March 31st, 2022)

Vaccination coupons have already been sent to all those eligible.

If you have not yet received your vaccination coupon, or if you have lost it, please call the Higashihiroshima City Call Center (see below).

For details of the locations where you can receive the vaccination, dates and times, how to make a reservation, etc., please check the information you received with the vaccination coupon.

### For those aged between 16 and 64 (including those with underlying diseases)

Vaccinations are due to begin from July, after vaccinations for those in the 65-and-over group have been completed. Depending on supplies of the vaccine, there may be changes to the schedule.

### Frequently-asked questions

Q1: I have a chronic illness, so I am worried about whether I should have the vaccination or not.

A1: Please discuss the situation with the doctor you normally visit, or with the consultants at the Hiroshima Prefecture Call Center.

Q2: My registered address is not in Higashihiroshima City. Can I receive the vaccination in the city?

A2: You can, but you will need the vaccination coupon sent to you from the municipality where your registered address is. There are additional formalities to be completed, so please check details with the Higashihiroshima City Call Center.

Q3: My registered address is in Higashihiroshima City. Can I receive the vaccination outside the city?

A3: You can, but you will need the vaccination coupon sent to you from Higashihiroshima City. There are additional formalities to be completed, so please check details with the municipality where you wish to receive the vaccination.

### Applications for 'Iki-iki Kodomo Club' for the summer period or starting from July 1st/August 1st

'Iki-iki Kodomo Club' is a care service at municipal elementary schools. Clubs with spare capacity are now accepting extra applications for use of the service during the summer vacation. For details, please see the application form. Forms are available from any of the clubs, from the Youth Development Division (Seishonen Ikusei-ka, 青少年育成課), from the branch offices, or from the sub-branch offices (from May). The application form can also be downloaded from the city website. Please note that depending on the capacity of the clubs, it may not be possible to join. To apply, please take or send the application form to the Youth Development Division, or take it to one of the branch offices.

#### Applications for summer holiday use:

Clubs with spare capacity accept applications for use of the service during the summer vacation. For details, please see the application form. If the club for your child's school is full, it is possible to use the club at a different school with places available (taking the child to the club and picking him/her up, and taking the child from his/her school to the club on days when it is necessary to go to school, is the responsibility of the parent/guardian).

Applications can be accepted for children (grades 1-6 of elementary school) from households where all members of the household (aged between 18 and 70) work for at least four hours between 8:00 and 18:00, at least three weekdays (Mondays to Fridays) a week.

The deadline for applications is 17:00 on Friday June 4th. Applications must be received by this time.

#### Applications for year-long use beginning from July or August:

The deadline for applications for year-long use beginning from July 1st is 17:00 on Friday June 4th, and the deadline for applications for year-long use beginning from August 1st is 17:00 on Friday June 18th.

### Certificates of tax payments for inspections of light vehicles

If your light vehicle is scheduled to undergo an inspection during the 2021-22 financial year and you will require a certificate of tax payment, please refer to the following.

If you have paid using tax payment slips, you will have been sent a notice and certificate of tax payments at the beginning of May. Please use this document. If you have paid using bank transfer, you will be sent a receipt and certificate of tax payments at the beginning of June. Please use this document.

If you have paid using your smartphone, you will not be sent a certificate of tax payments. If you need this document please apply for one to be issued.

### Special system for National Pension Scheme payments by students

Those aged 20 or over are required to enrol in the National Pension Scheme. This is the case even for students. However, there is a special system for National Pension Scheme payments by students, by which the payments can be postponed if the individual's income is below a certain level.

Current students at educational facilities specified by the School Education Act whose income for the previous year is below a certain level are eligible to apply for postponements. These educational facilities include universities (graduate schools), colleges, high schools, specialist high schools, vocational schools, and other schools (the enrolled course being one year or more). The upper income limit for the previous year's income is 1,280,000 yen, but this amount may differ if the student has dependent relatives, social insurance deductions, etc.

When applying, you will need to include a certificate of enrolment (not a copy), or a copy of your student ID. If you received an application form (a postcard) from the Japan Pension Service, please fill in the postcard with the necessary details and return it.

It is possible to make the payments for the period in which your payments were postponed, within 10 years of the period.

Those fulfilling all of the following criteria are eligible to apply:

1. People who have an address in Higashihiroshima City, or whose place of work is in Higashihiroshima City.
2. People who are currently living with a relative, or intending to live with a relative (there are separate criteria for single people).
3. People whose income falls below a certain level (please enquire for details).
4. People who are not in arrears with municipal taxes.
5. People who are currently having trouble with housing.
6. People who are not members of criminal gangs.

Please note that it is not possible to keep pets in municipal apartments.

Applications will be accepted between Monday May 17th and Friday May 21st, at the Housing Division only (applications can also be posted). Application forms and details are available from the Housing Division (Jutaku-ka, 住宅課), or from branch offices and sub-branch offices, from Monday May 10th. Details of the amount of applications up until the previous day will be made public at the Housing Division and at each of the branch offices.

**Notice of municipal and prefectural tax amounts (special collection at source) payable based on income from wages**

- ・ 給与所得等に係る市民税・県民税
- ・ 特別徴収税額の決定通知の送信

Notices of the amounts of municipal and prefectural tax payable during the 2021-22 financial year (based on income from wages) will be sent during May to those with the responsibility for special collection of tax (wage payers).

Those who are responsible for paying the tax (wage earners) should obtain a notice of the amount to be paid from their wage payer.

As a measure to prevent the spread of COVID-19 infections, the period for filing income tax returns for 2020 was extended to April 15th, 2021. As a result of this, if a final tax return was submitted on or after March 16th, 2021, the details may not be reflected accurately on the first notice of the amount of tax to be paid. In this case, the amounts of tax payable will be altered as the tax returns are processed.

If your tax amount has been altered, you will be sent a new notice to inform you of the revised amount.

Please pay Light Vehicle and Motorcycle Tax by Monday May 31st.

You can pay municipal taxes at a convenience store, or using a smartphone. A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

※ **Note:** it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

**Night-time and holiday duty hospitals:**

Full information about night-time and holiday duty hospitals within Higashihiroshima City is published in the Japanese-language version of the monthly city newsletter 'Higashihiroshima' (the page inside the back cover; only in Japanese), and on the Higashihiroshima City website (in Japanese and English).

The information is subject to change at short notice, so before going to a medical facility, please be sure to call to confirm details.

Recently, there are more and more patients using emergency medical facilities at night and on holidays even though their situation is not serious. In some cases, these patients have prevented or delayed the treatment of patients with truly serious illnesses, and additionally, such cases are one of the reasons for doctors becoming overworked. Emergency medical facilities open at night and on holidays are for patients with serious, emergency conditions. Please try to visit the medical facility you use normally, during opening hours on weekdays.

**Emergency medical treatment for children:**

Please call the advice line on #8000 (if you cannot get through on this number, please call 082-505-1399). The service is available every day between 19:00 and 8:00 the following morning. You can obtain information about whether or not you should take your child to a medical facility outside of normal opening hours (at nights, on weekends or holidays, etc.).

**If you have a medical problem at night or on weekends, and you are unsure about whether or not you should go to a medical facility:**

Please call the Hiroshima area emergency consultation center on #7119. The service is free, and is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The staff will be able to give you advice on whether to rest at home and see how symptoms develop, or whether you should go to a medical facility. If necessary, they can give you information about which facility to go to, or they can connect you directly to the 119 emergency service.

In an emergency, do not hesitate to phone 119.
