Genki Sukoyaka Health Checks will begin soon!

- 元氣すこやか健診が

From 2024, health check fees (the portion paid by the individual) will be free for those enrolled in the Higashihiroshima City National Health Insurance. There is no need to apply for a Certificate of Eligibility for Free Health Checks. (Excluding basic medical examinations for those under 39 years of age.)

● People who will be sent health check vouchers:

1. Women over 20 years old, of an even-numbered age;
2. Those over 40 years old;
3. Those aged 20 years old and 30 years old, who are eligible for milestone periodontal disease screening.



Health check vouchers will be sent in an envelope like this

than usual. In addition, there are capacity limits at some health check locations. As soon as you receive your health check vouchers, please be sure to check the enclosed Genki Sukoyaka health check guide.

○ Medical institution health checks

These are available from Saturday June 1st, 2024 to Friday January 31st, 2025.

Please contact a medical institution directly to apply (you will need to take your health check vouchers)

○ Please take a milestone periodontal disease check!

Eligibility for the milestone periodontal disease check has been extended to those of 20 and 30 years of age from this year. Periodontal disease is a lifestyle disease that can progress without obvious pain. Please take this opportunity to have your own dental health checked.

Those aged 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 and 70 are eligible.

Amount to be paid by the individual: 500 yen.

(The check is free for those enrolled in the Higashihiroshima City National Health Insurance, and for 70-year-olds.)

Please contact a dental clinic directly to apply (you will need to take your health check vouchers)

● How to apply for a Certificate of Eligibility for Free Health Checks

You can apply on the web or in person.

If you have not applied for a Certificate of Eligibility for Free Health Checks, or you do not bring your certificate with you to the health check, you will be charged a medical examination fee. Please note that you cannot apply for reimbursement after the health check.

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Group health checks	Apply using the application postcard or online. Those eligible will be sent a medical examination form and a Certificate of Eligibility for Free Health Checks from the city.
Medical institution health checks	Before the health check, please apply for a Certificate of Eligibility for Free Health Checks. When applying, you will need an identity verification document (your My Number card, health insurance card, driver's license, etc.) or your Genki Sukoyaka Health Check vouchers. You can apply online, or in person (at the Medical Treatment and Health Division, or at a branch office or sub-branch office of the City Office. Note that Fukutomi Branch Office and the sub-branch offices only accept applications. Certificates of Eligibility for Free Health Checks cannot be issued).

For both group health checks and medical institution health checks, if your tax status is unable to be checked because you have moved into the city from elsewhere, please bring a certificate of items recorded on the tax register from municipal and prefectural tax for the 2024-25 financial year (the 2023 calendar year), for all members of the household.

The medical expenses payments scheme for infants and toddlers will change

From October, this scheme will change as shown in the table below. Accordingly, we will send information in early June to parents of children who are not currently eligible for benefits (please contact us if you do not receive the information until mid-June).

Please note that your current certificate of eligibility is valid until you receive a new certificate of eligibility (the timing of when you will receive your new certificate of eligibility will vary depending on your child's birth month).

Municipal and prefectural tax payment notices will be sent to you by post on June 3rd, reflecting the fixed amount tax reduction for your tax amount for the 2024-25 financial year.

If your workplace has changed due to a job change, you will receive a tax notice, so if you wish to have your salary deducted at your new workplace, please contact your employer.

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Please pay Municipal and Prefectural Tax and Forest Environment Tax (the first installment) by Monday July 1st.

A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

※ **Note:** it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

Night-time and holiday hospitals

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• **Night-time and holiday duty hospitals:** Full information about night-time and holiday duty hospitals within Higashihiroshima City is published in the Japanese-language version of the monthly city newsletter 'Higashihiroshima' (the page inside the back cover; only in Japanese), and on the Higashihiroshima City website (in Japanese and English). The information is subject to change at short notice, so before going to a medical facility, please be sure to call to confirm details.

Recently, there are more and more patients using emergency medical facilities at night and on holidays even though their situation is not serious. In some cases, these patients have prevented or delayed the treatment of patients with truly serious illnesses, and additionally, such cases are one of the reasons for doctors becoming overworked. Emergency medical facilities open at night and on holidays are for patients with serious, emergency conditions. Please try to visit the medical facility you use normally, during opening hours on weekdays.

• **Emergency medical treatment for children:** Please call the advice line on #8000 (if you cannot get through on this number, please call 082-505-1399). The service is available every day between 19:00 and 8:00 the following morning. You can obtain information about whether or not you should take your child to a medical facility outside of normal opening hours (at nights, on weekends or holidays, etc.).

• **If you have a medical problem at night or on weekends, and you are unsure about whether or not you should go to a medical facility:** Please call the Hiroshima area emergency consultation center on #7119. The service is free, and is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The staff will be able to give you advice on whether to rest at home and see how symptoms develop, or whether you should go to a medical facility. If necessary, they can give you information about which facility to go to, or they can connect you directly to the 119 emergency service. In an emergency, do not hesitate to phone 119.

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The counters of the Citizens' Affairs Division are open until 19:00 every Thursday evening (except national holidays and the new year/year-end period. Wherever possible, please take someone with you who speaks Japanese. **Please note that divisions other than the Citizens' Affairs Division are not open at these times.** For details of what matters can be dealt with during these extended opening hours, and what you need to bring with you, please access the QR Code to the right to check the city website.

If you have a My Number Card, you can use it to obtain Certificates of Residence, etc., at convenience stores.

Please be aware that formalities relating to My Number Cards cannot be dealt with.
