The above is the schedule for public services in Higashihiroshima over the New Year Holidays, 2024-2025.

Household garbage collection will be conducted according to the schedule shown on the garbage collection calendar. Applications for family register registration and burial/cremation permission are accepted at the after-hours counters of the City Office, and each branch office and sub-branch office.

Coming-of-Age Ceremony (Hatachi no Tsudoi) : 二十歳のつどい

The Hatachi no Tsudoi, otherwise known as the 'Coming-of-Age Ceremony', is an annual event held on the second Monday of January to celebrate young people who have become adults.

Although Japan lowered the legal age of adulthood from 20 to 18 on April 1, 2022, Higashihiroshima City will continue to hold the ceremony for those who turn 20 during the relevant fiscal year, following past practice.

During the ceremony, new adults from the region are invited to a large venue, where they receive commemorative gifts and congratulatory messages from the mayor. A representative of the new adults may also give a pledge expressing their commitment upon entering adulthood.

Attire for the ceremony is free of choice. Many women wear furisode (a formal long-sleeved kimono), while men typically wear suits in calm colors such as navy, black, or gray. Some participants wear traditional clothing from their home countries.



The event will be held on Monday January 12, 2026 (a National Holiday), in two sessions:

Session 1: 11:00-11:30 (Doors open 10:15, reception closes 10:45)

Session 2: 14:00-14:30 (Doors open 13:00, reception closes 13:45)

It will take place at Higashihiroshima Arts & Culture Hall Kurara, in the Main Hall.

Individuals born between April 2, 2005 and April 1, 2006 are eligible to attend. You may participate even if you are not registered as a resident of the city.

Notice to Participants: invitation postcards (entry tickets) were sent on August 22, 2025. Those who do not have the postcard should present an ID document (such as a residence card) at the reception on the day.

Your child should receive the Japanese encephalitis and the type-2 combined (diphtheria/tetanus) vaccinations before turning 13

To maintain the immunity gained during early childhood, booster vaccinations are necessary.

Special Eligibility for Japanese Encephalitis Vaccination:

There was a period when active recommendation for the Japanese encephalitis vaccine was suspended.

If you were eligible during that time and did not receive the vaccination, you may receive the missing doses for free, depending on your age.

Please check your child's Maternal and Child Health Handbook and have your child complete any missing vaccinations.

Japanese Encephalitis (second dose)	Type-2 combined (diphtheria/tetanus) (booster dose)
Those aged 9 or older but under 13, who have their resident registration in this city. Special-case eligible individuals (those born between April 2, 2005 and April 1, 2007). ※ Before turning 20, they must receive any missing doses out of the four required vaccinations.	Those aged 11 or older but under 13 who have their resident registration in this city.

To receive the vaccinations, make a reservation with an implementing medical institution (listed on the city's website).

On the day of the vaccination, take the child's Maternal and Child Health Handbook and the pre-examination form.

Vaccination forms (pre-examination forms) are available at the Medical and Health Division, each branch office (except Fukutomi), and participating medical institutions.

If you wish your child to get vaccinated outside the city, advance procedures are required.

Date & Time: Friday January 2, 2026, 6:45-8:00 (cancelled in case of snow or rain).

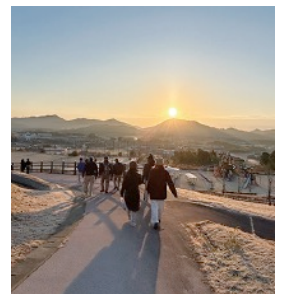
Meeting Location: Kurose Indoor Pool (10018-4 Narahara, Kurose-cho)

Registration: Same-day registration (6:30-6:45)

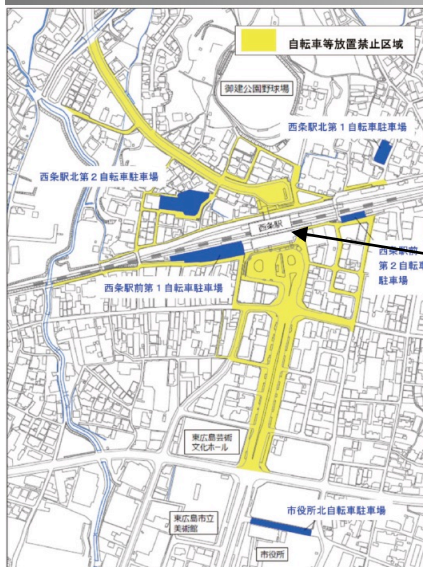
Note: Only first-aid treatment will be provided for any injuries during the event.

Please pay Fixed Asset Tax and City Planning Tax (the third installment) and the National Health Insurance Premium (the sixth installment) by Thursday December 25. A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

※ **Note:** it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

Night-time and holiday hospitals

• **Night-time and holiday duty hospitals:** Full information about night-time and holiday duty hospitals within Higashihiroshima City is published in the Japanese-language version of the monthly city newsletter 'Higashihiroshima' (the page inside the back cover; only in Japanese), and on the Higashihiroshima City website (in Japanese and English). The information is subject to change at short notice, so before going to a medical facility, please be sure to call to confirm details.

Recently, there are more and more patients using emergency medical facilities at night and on holidays even though their situation is not serious. In some cases, these patients have prevented or delayed the treatment of patients with truly serious illnesses, and additionally, such cases are one of the reasons for doctors becoming overworked. Emergency medical facilities open at night and on holidays are for patients with serious, emergency conditions. Please try to visit the medical facility you use normally, during opening hours on weekdays.

• **Emergency medical treatment for children:** Please call the advice line on #8000 (if you cannot get through on this number, please call 082-505-1399). The service is available every day between 19:00 and 8:00 the following morning. You can obtain information about whether or not you should take your child to a medical facility outside of normal opening hours (at nights, on weekends or holidays, etc.).

• **If you have a medical problem at night or on weekends, and you are unsure about whether or not you should go to a medical facility:** Please call the Hiroshima area emergency consultation center on #7119. The service is free, and is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The staff will be able to give you advice on whether to rest at home and see how symptoms develop, or whether you should go to a medical facility. If necessary, they can give you information about which facility to go to, or they can connect you directly to the 119 emergency service. In an emergency, do not hesitate to phone 119.

**Citizens' Affairs Division: Out-of-hours opening**

The counters of the Citizens' Affairs Division are open until 19:00 on the first and third Thursdays of the month (except national holidays and the new year/year-end period). The dates for December are December 4 and December 18.

In addition, there is Sunday opening on December 14, from 9:00 to 12:00. Wherever possible, please take someone with you who speaks Japanese. **Please note that divisions other than the Citizens' Affairs Division are not open at these times.** For details of what matters can be dealt with during these extended opening hours, and what you need to bring with you, please access the QR Code to the right to check the city website.

If you have a My Number Card, you can use it to obtain Certificates of Residence, etc., at convenience stores.

Please be aware that formalities relating to My Number Cards cannot be dealt with.
